IMPORTANT

- * Do not tighten up all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- * You should keep Allen Key in a safe place as you may need to tighten up the Bolts in the future.
- * After assembly, item must be level to work properly. use the included adjustable levelers to level
- * Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.

Attach Dividers (I) and (J) to Front Rail (L) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 1)

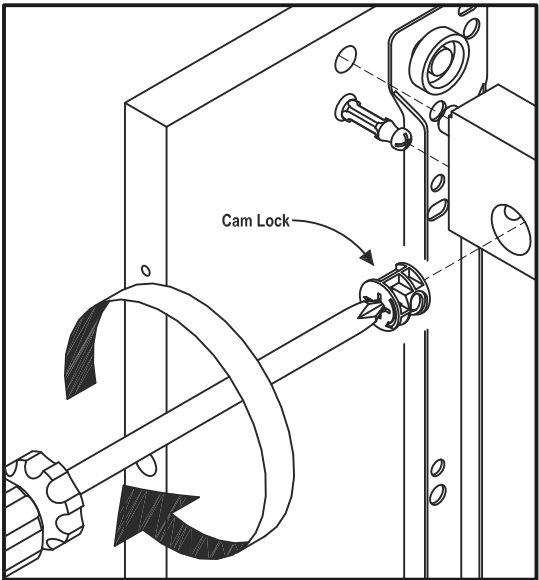
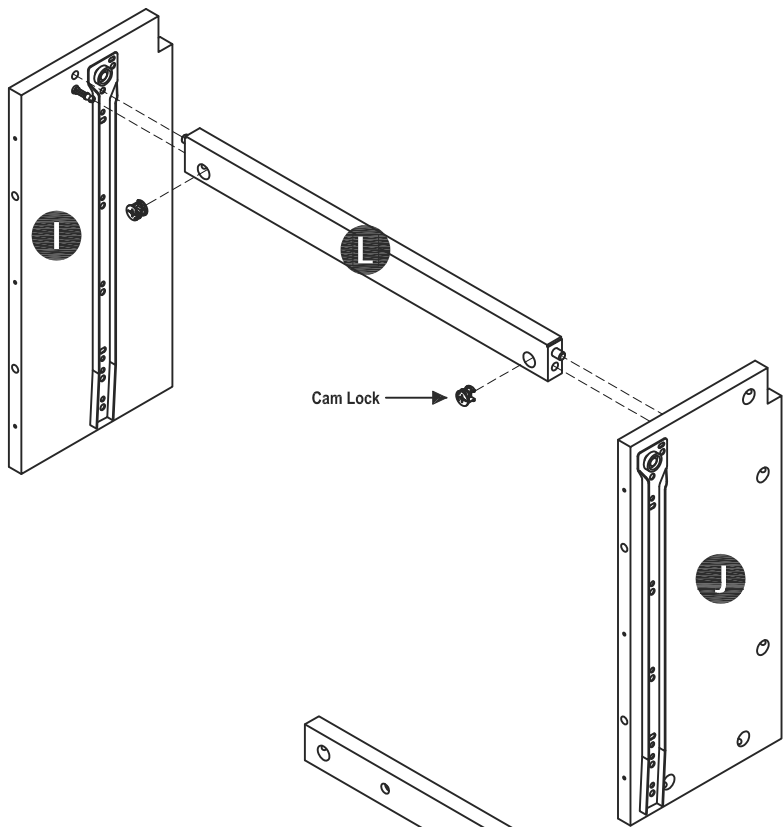
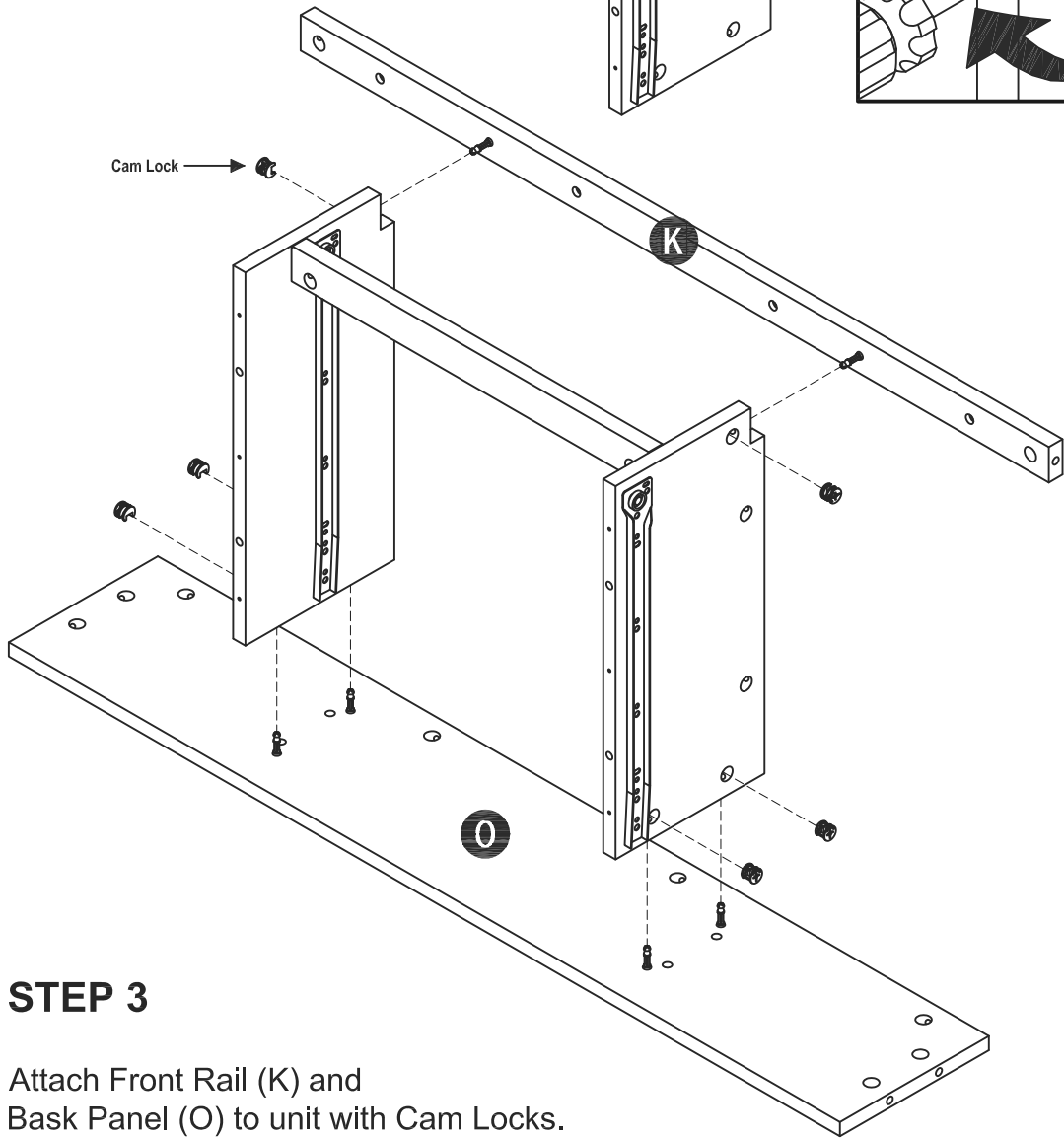

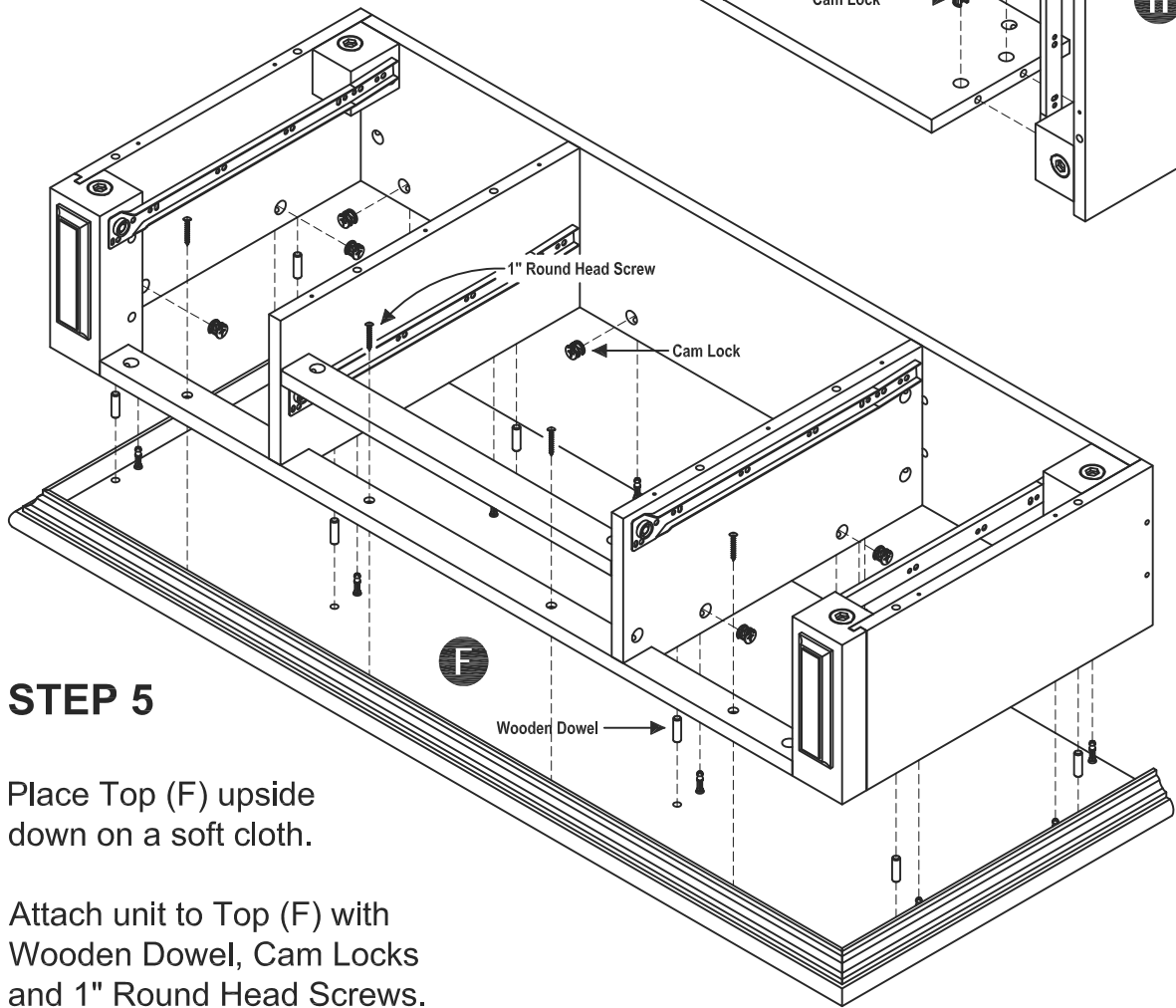
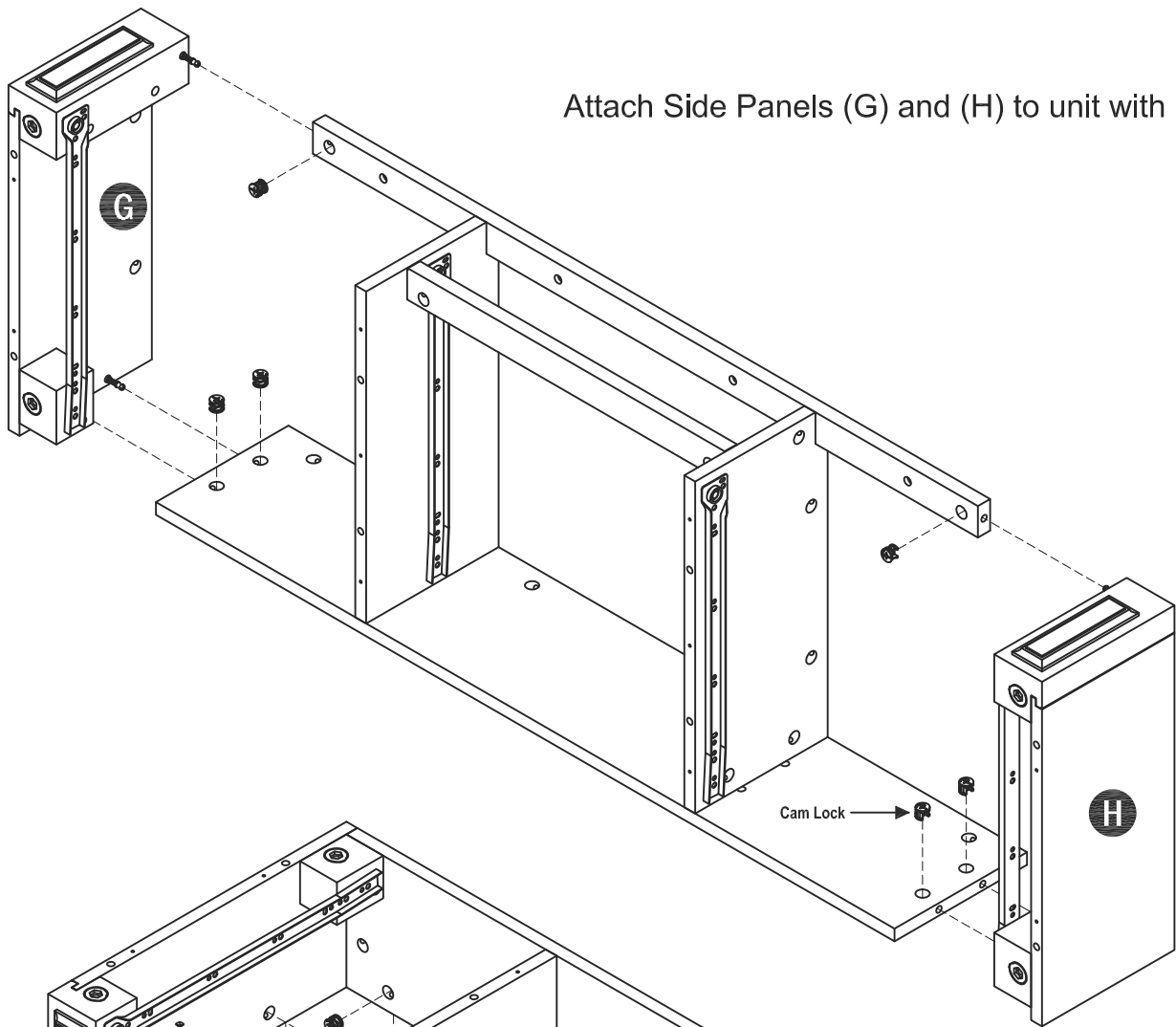


STEP 3

Attach Front Rail (K) and Bask Panel (O) to unit with Cam Locks.

STEP 4

Attach Side Panels (G) and (H) to unit with Cam Locks.



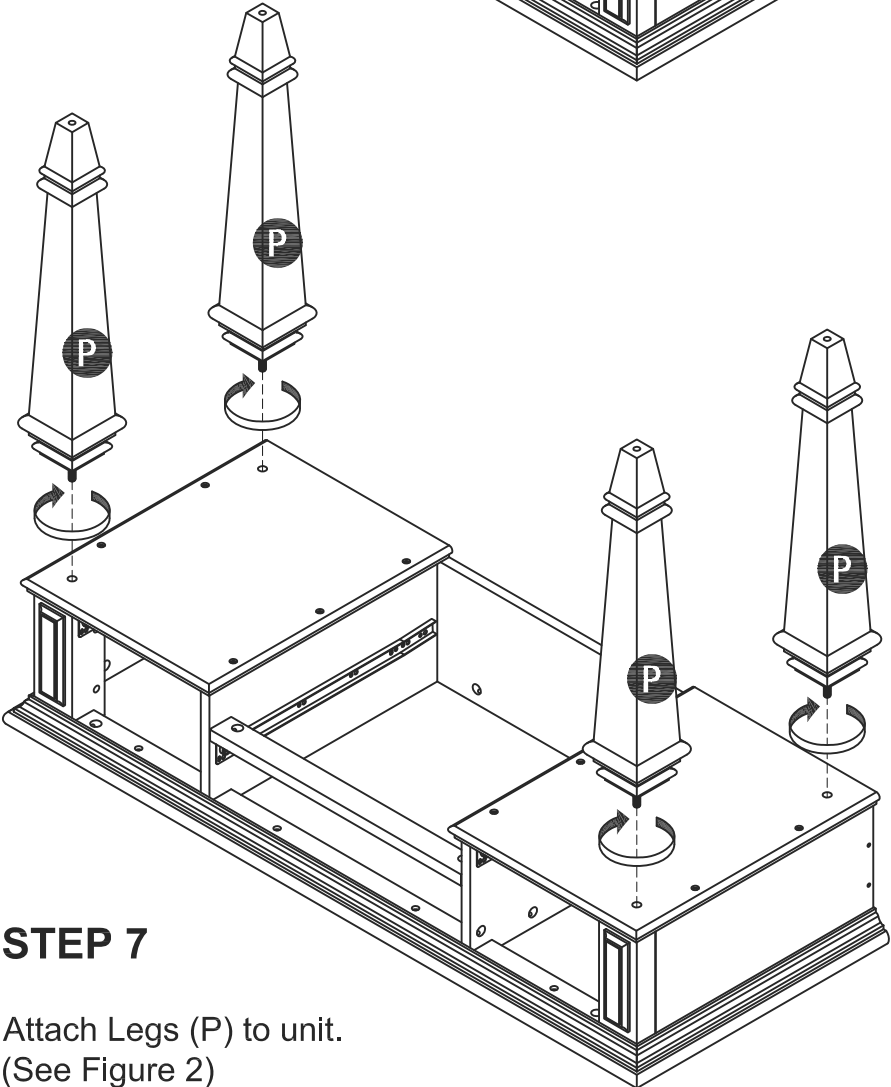
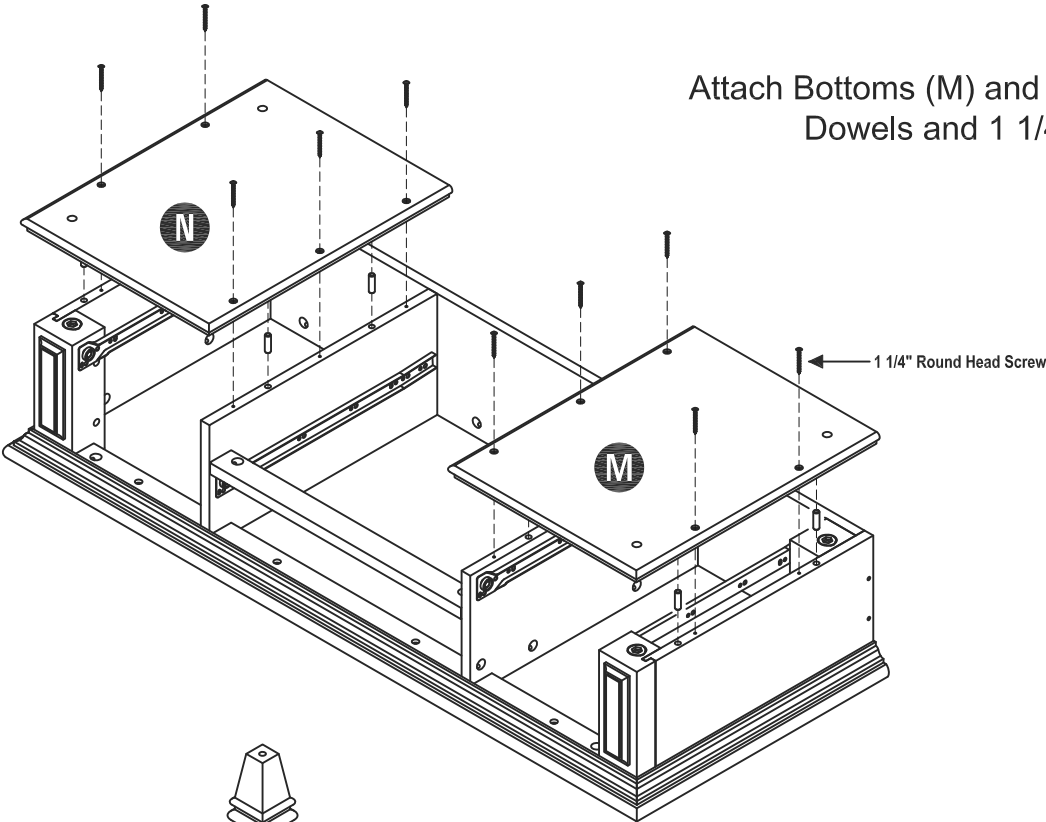
STEP 5

Place Top (F) upside down on a soft cloth.

Attach unit to Top (F) with Wooden Dowel, Cam Locks and 1" Round Head Screws.

STEP 6

Attach Bottoms (M) and (N) to unit with Wooden Dowels and 1 1/4" Round Head Screws.



STEP 7

Attach Legs (P) to unit.

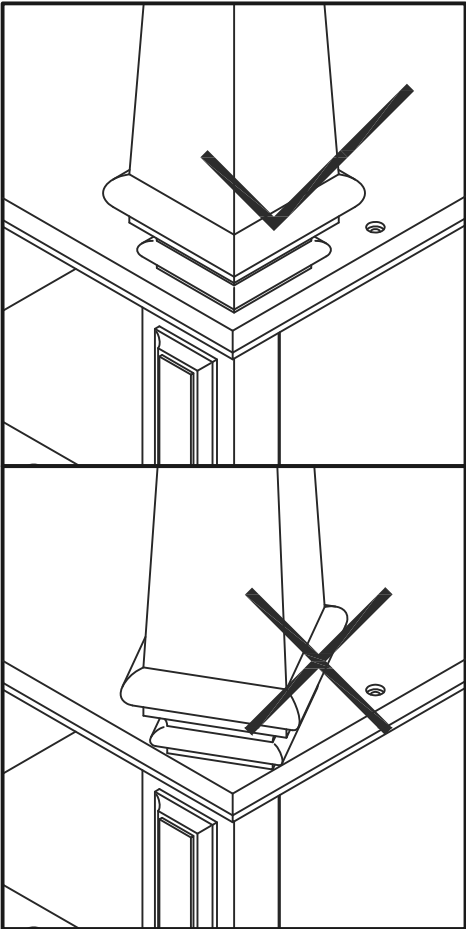
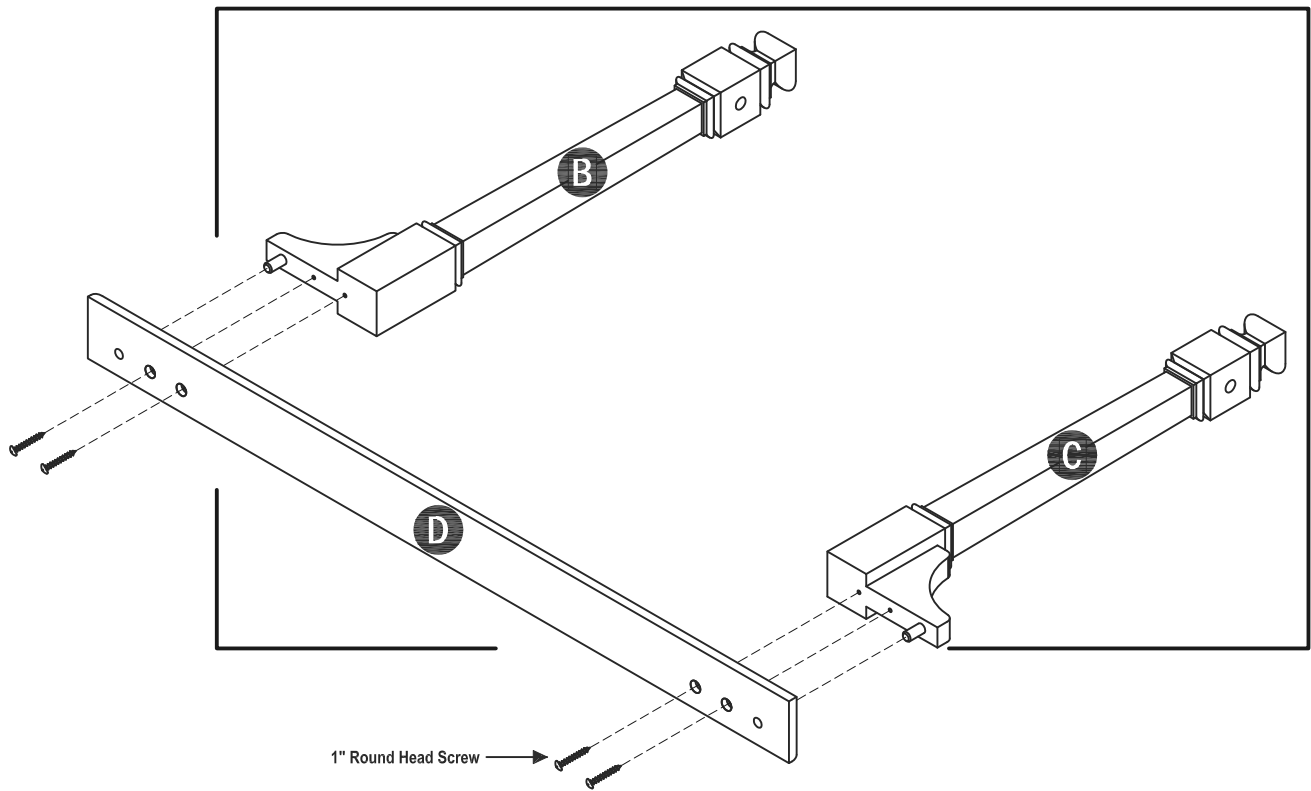

STEP 8

Attach Mirror Supports (B) and (C) to Mirror Support (D) with 1" Round Head Screws.



STEP 9

Attach Mirror (A) to unit with Axis Bolts, Mirror Axis and Plastic Washers. (See Figure 3)

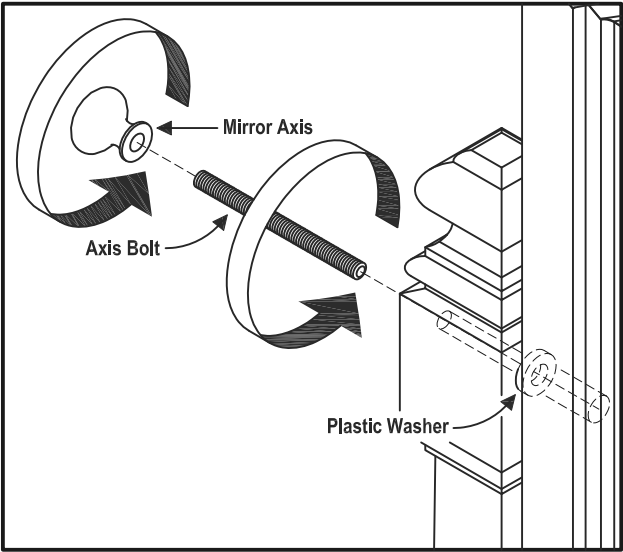
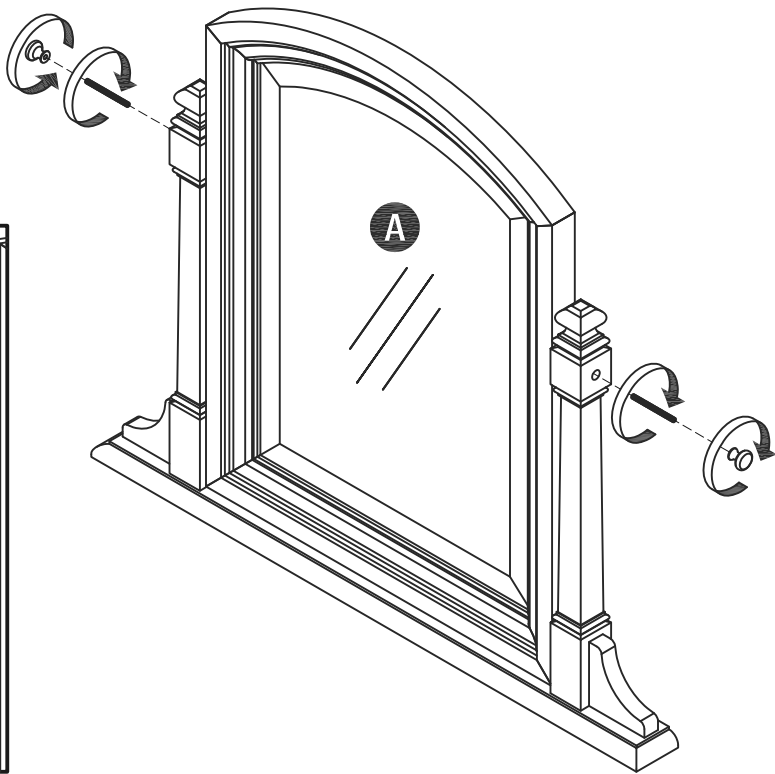

STEP 10

Attach Mirror Supports (B), (C) and (E) to unit with Bolts, Flat Washers and Spring Washers.

Tighten with Allen Key.
(See Figure 4)

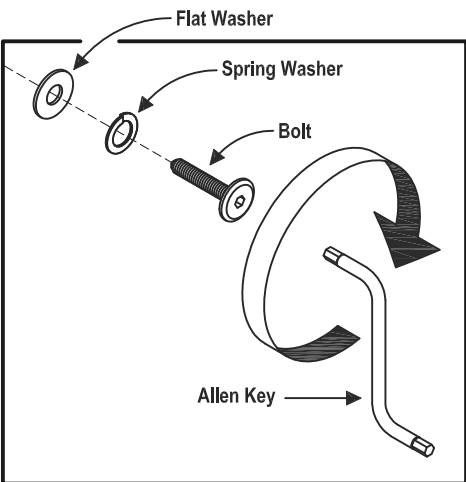

STEP 11

Slide Drawers (Q) and (R) into position.

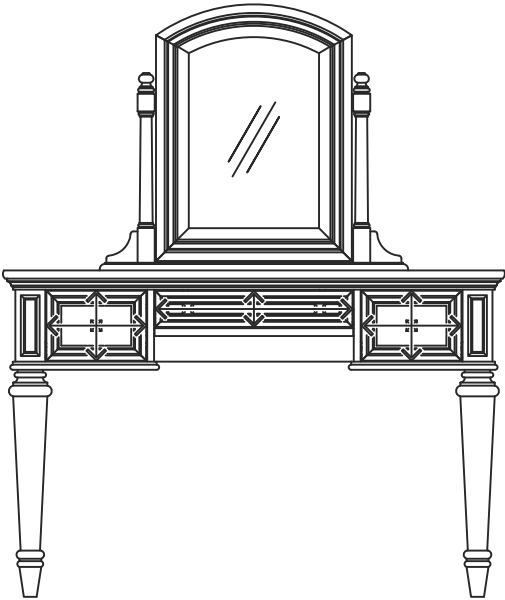
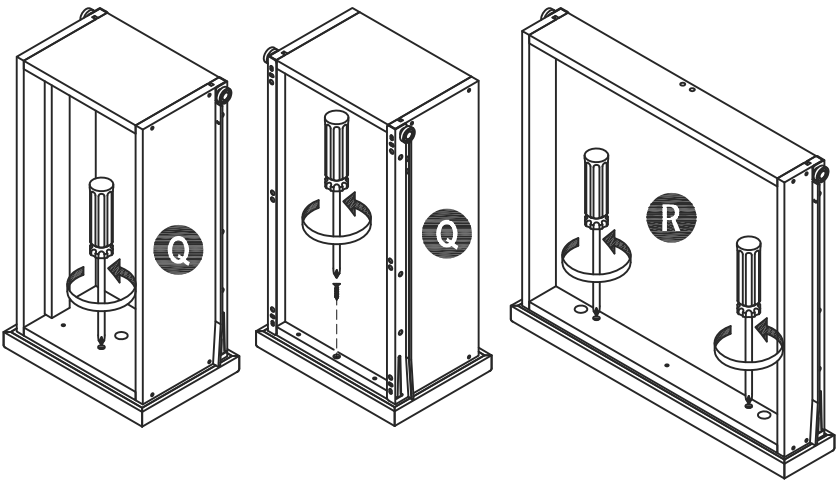
To level the unit, adjust the adjustable levelers on the bottom of unit.
(See Figure 5)

Note: Follow the steps on the next page to use 3/4" Flat Head Screws to complete drawer assembly.

STEP 12

For Drawer (Q) loosen slightly the upper center screw and uninstall the lower center screw.

For Drawer (R) loosen slightly the two screws pre-installed on the back of the drawer fronts.

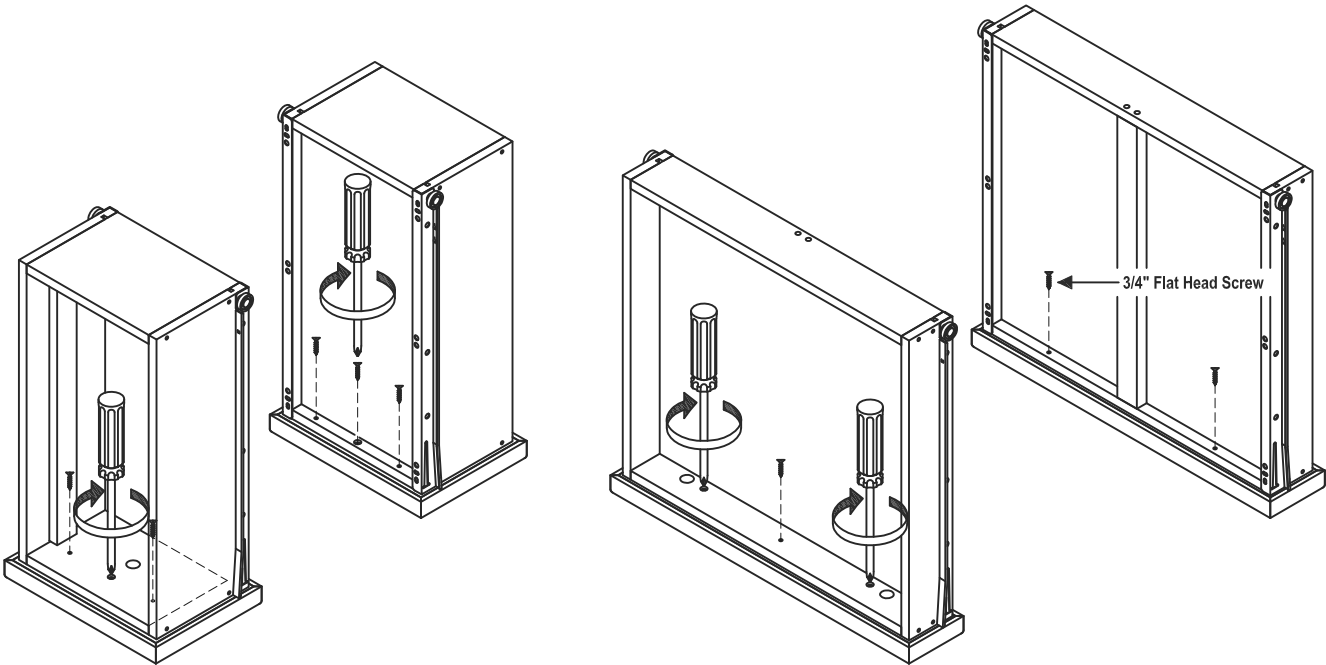


STEP 13

Insert the drawer into the main body, then adjust the drawer front panel left or right and up or down until the drawer gaps look proportional.

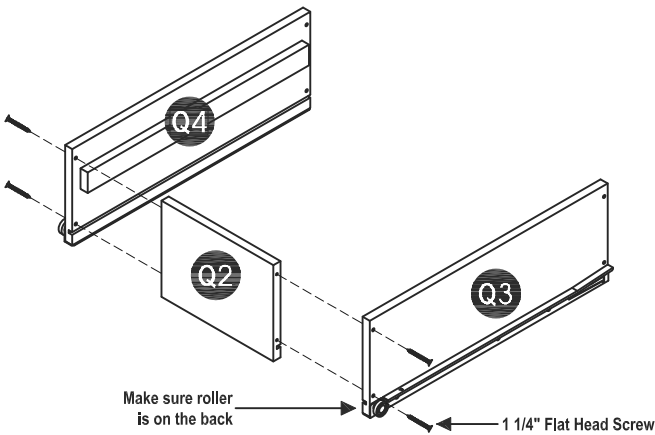
STEP 14

Pull the drawer open slowly and re-tighten the screws from Step 12. Make sure the front panel does not move and lock the drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.

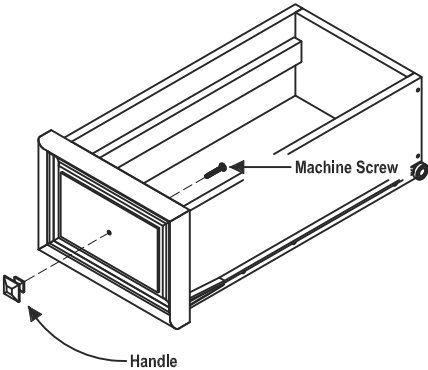
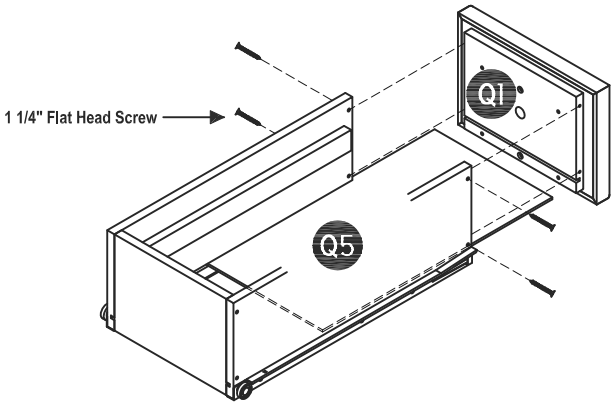
STEP 1

Insert Base Part (Q5) into the groove.

Attach Front Part (Q1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

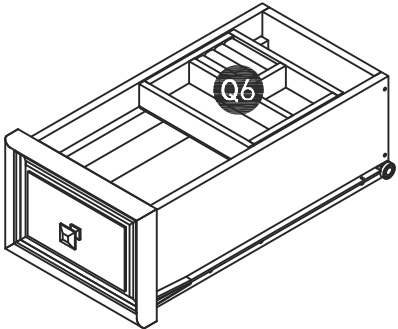


STEP 3

Attach Handle with Machine Screws.







STEP 4

Place Jewelry Box (Q6) into position.

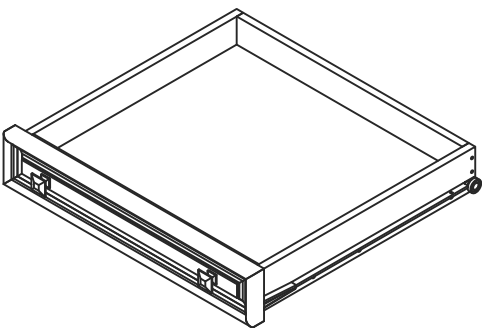

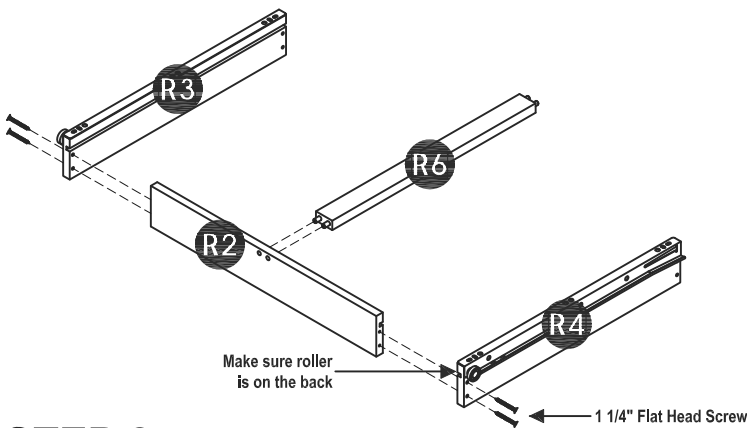

Attach Side Parts (R3) and (R4) to Back Part (R2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

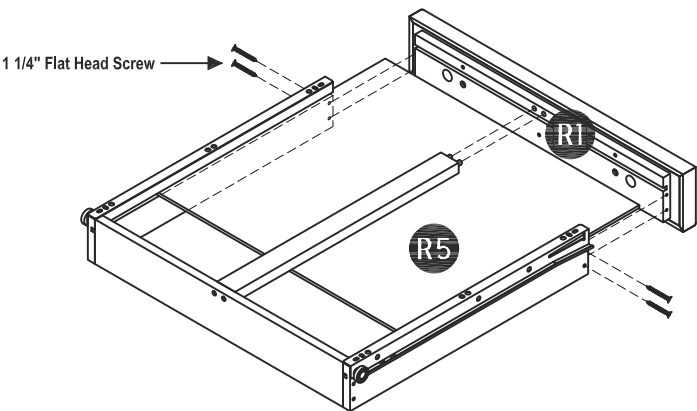
Attach Base Part (R6) to Back Part (R2).



STEP 2

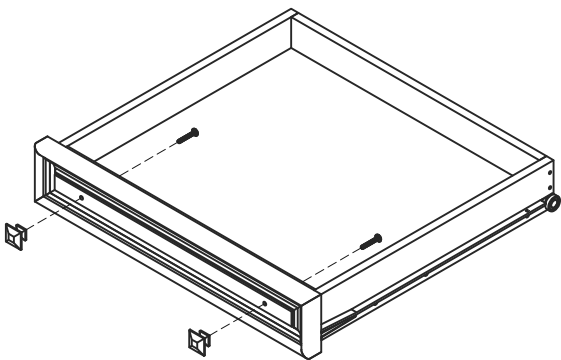
Insert Base Part (R5) into the groove.

Attach Front Part (R1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.



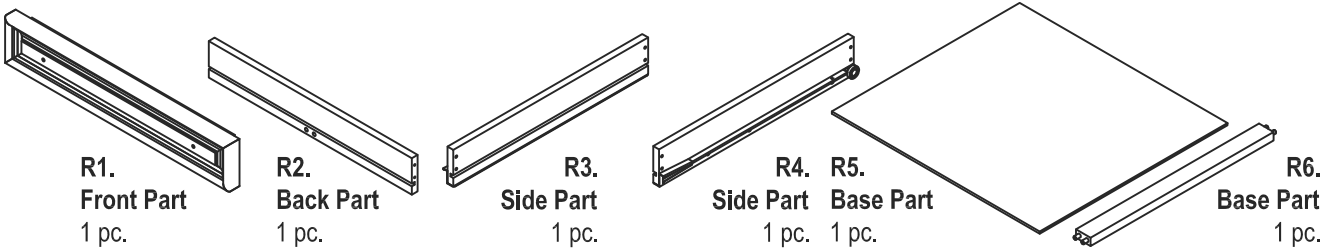
