
STEP 1


Attach Side Part (G3) to Front Part (G1) and Back Part (G2) using 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

STEP 2


Insert Base Part (G5) into the groove.

Attach Side Part (G4) to unit using 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.






Attach Handle with Machine Screws.




Assembly Instructions 5/5

I. IF DRAWER DOES NOT ALIGN STEP 1

Loosen slighty the upper screws.




STEP 2



Insert the drawer into the main body, then adjust the drawer front panel left or right and up or down, until the drawer gaps look proportional.

II. IF DRAWER ALREADY ALIGNS

Pull out drawer slowly. Lock the drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.



Pull the drawer open slowly and tighten the upper screws. Make sure the front panel does not move and lock the drawer front panel into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.
