
- * Do not tighten up all the bolts until each part is properly assembled.
- * You should keep Hex Wrench in a safe place as you may need to tighten up the Head Cap Bolts in the future.
- * Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- * After assembly item must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.



STEP 1


Place Top (A) on a soft cloth.

Remove all drawers.





Attach Stretcher (D) to Side Frame (C) with Steel Plate, Flat Washers and Head Cap Bolts (short).

Attach Side Frame (B) to unit with Flat Washers, Spring Washers, Head Cap Bolts (long), Steel Plate and Head Cap Bolts (short).



Insert Threaded Bolts into the pre-drilled holes in bottom of unit.





STEP 5

Attach Finials (I) to unit.

Slide drawers into position.

To level the unit, adjust the adjustable levelers on the bottom of legs. (See Figure 1)

Note: Unit must be level to work properly.


