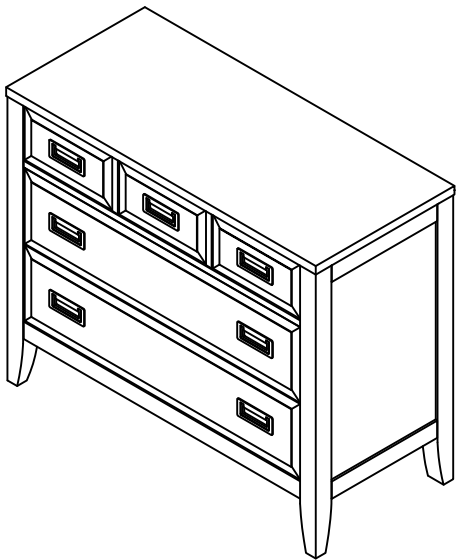

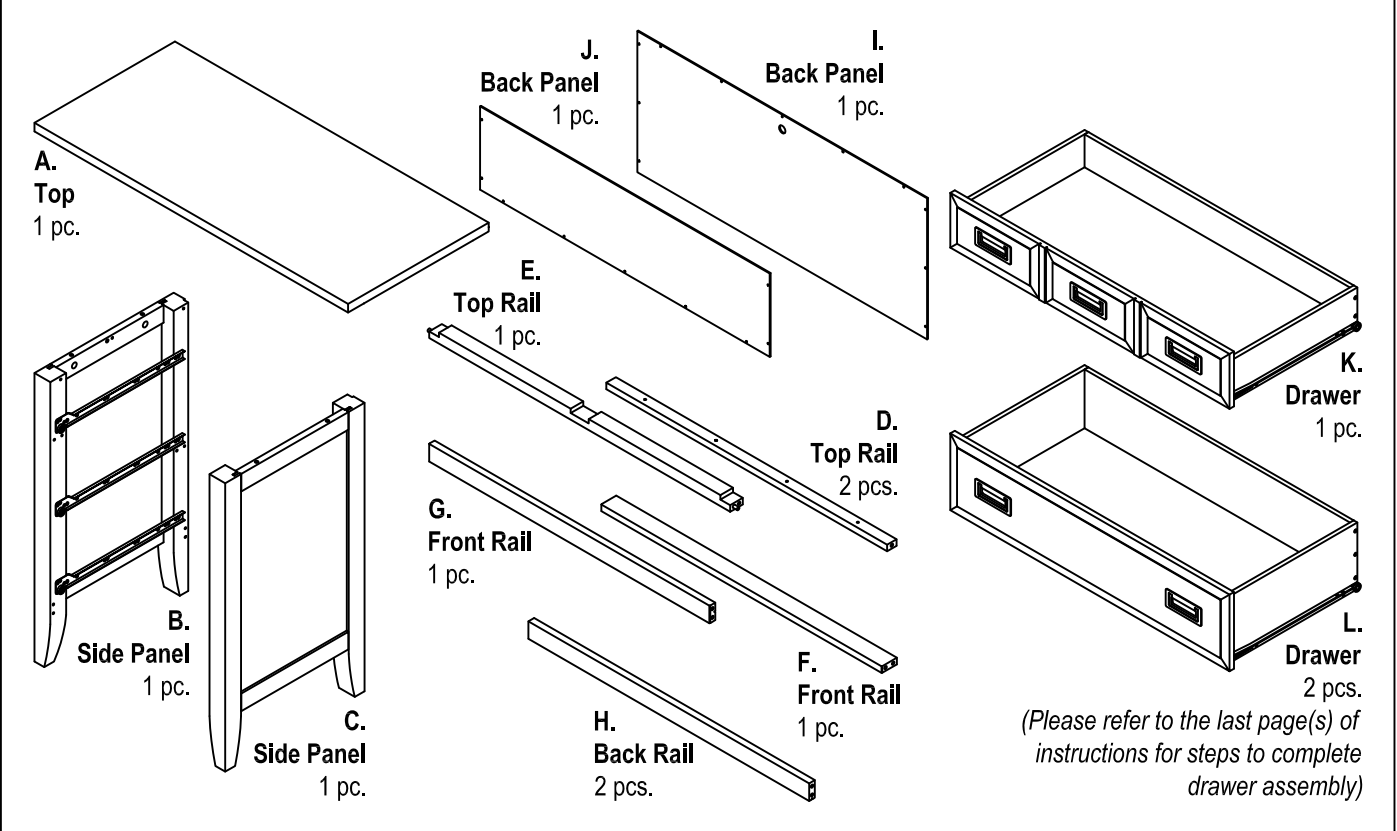
Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and put them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damages occuring to the parts.

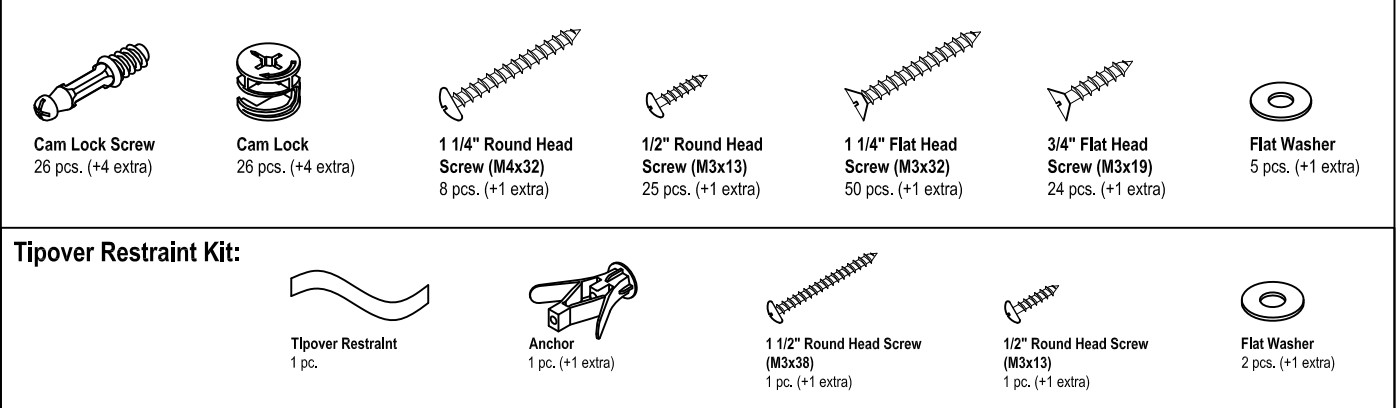

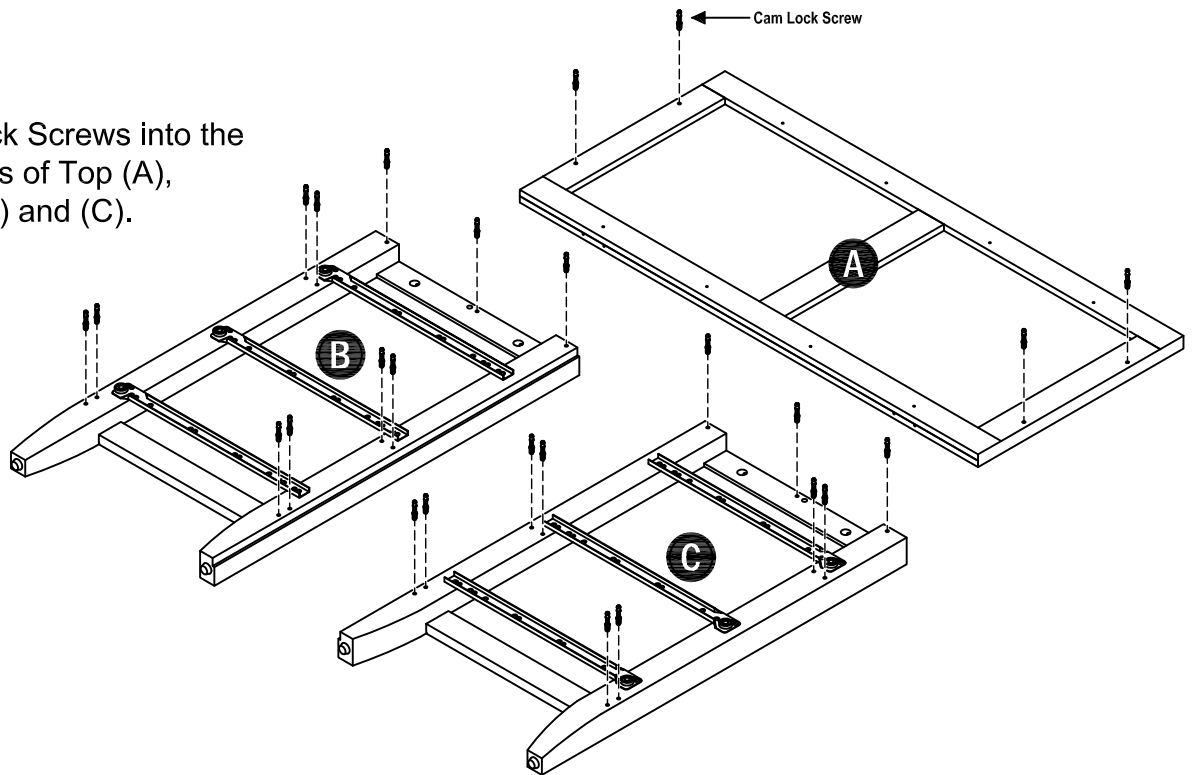

## IMPORTANT

- \* Do not tighten up all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- \* Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- \* After assembly, item must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levellers to level.

## STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into the pre-drilled holes of Top (A), Side Panels (B) and (C).



## STEP 2

Attach Top Rails (D) and (E), Front Rails (F) and (G) and Back Rails (H) to Side Panel (B) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 1)

Please orientate Rail (F) so notch on ends of rail is to the front edge of Side Panel (B).

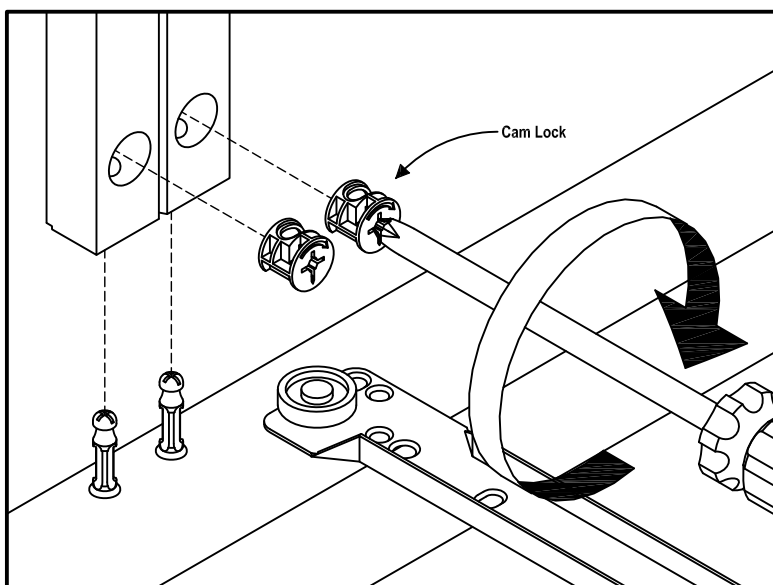
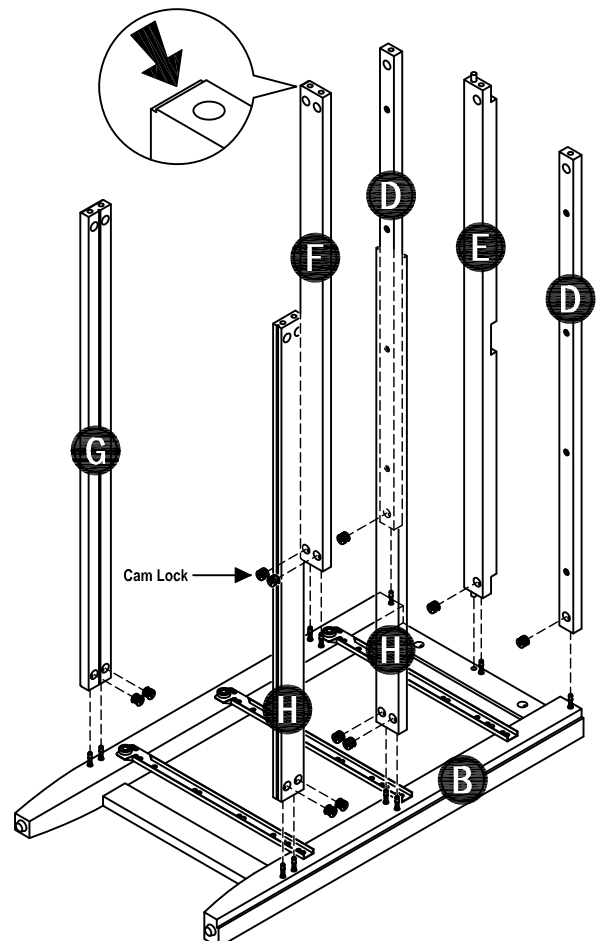
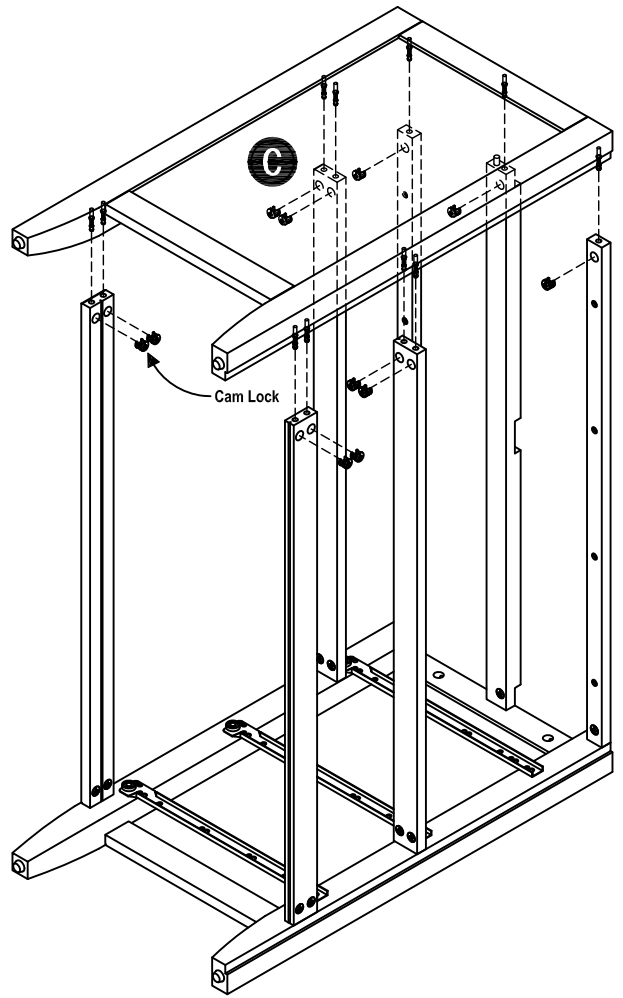

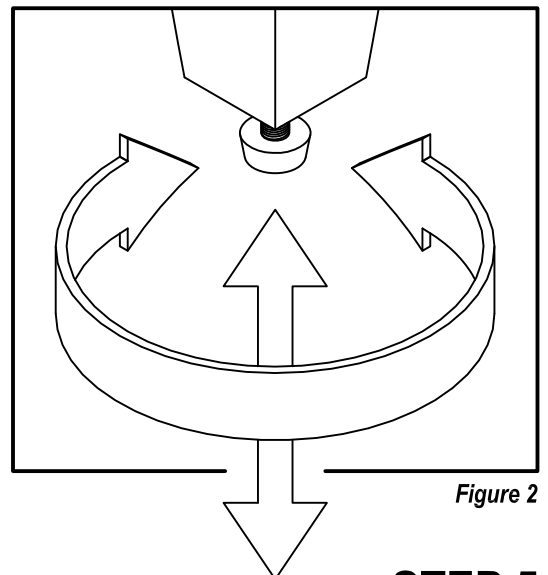
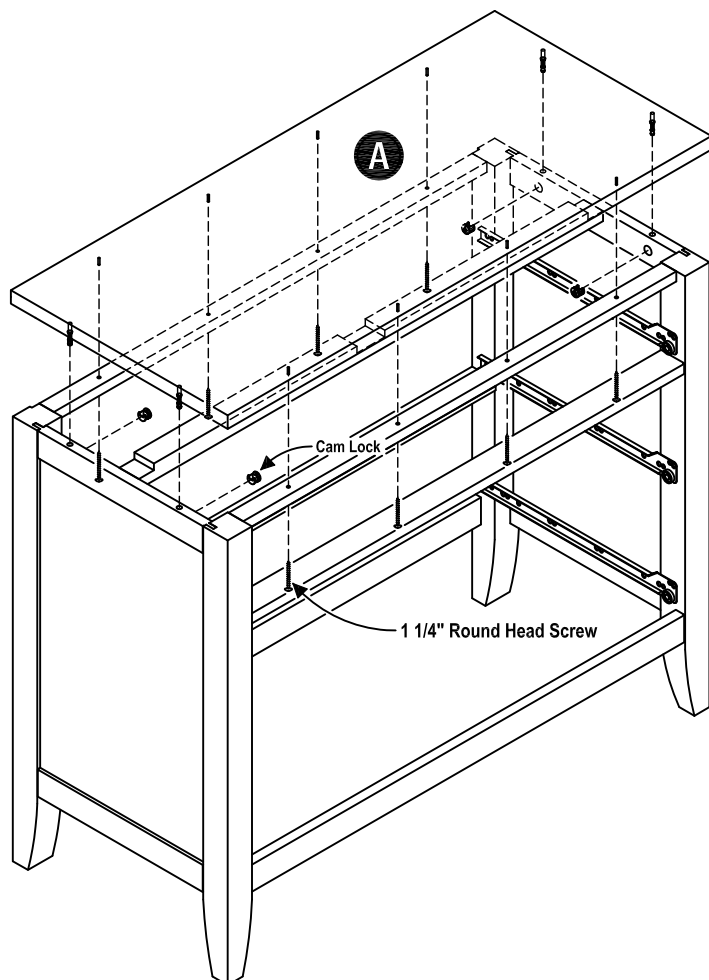
## STEP 3

Attach Side Panel (C) to unit with Cam Locks.  
(See Figure 1)



## STEP 4

Attach Top (A) to unit with Cam Locks and 1 1/4" Round Head Screws.  
**Note: A Philips screwdriver 5" or less in length is recommended.**



## STEP 5

To level the unit, adjust the adjustable levelers on the bottom of the feet.

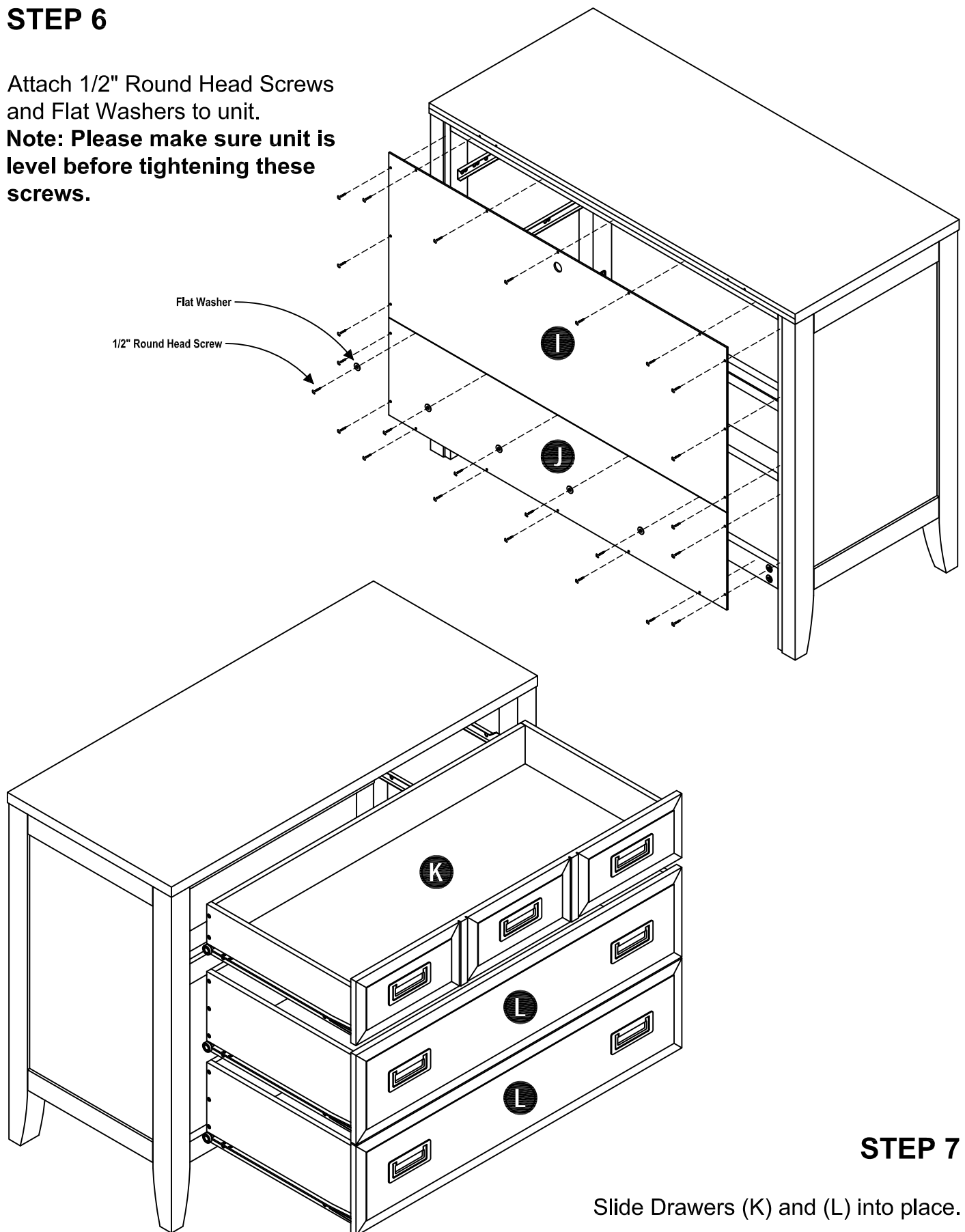
**Note: Unit must be level to work properly.**

## STEP 6

Attach 1/2" Round Head Screws and Flat Washers to unit.

**Note: Please make sure unit is level before tightening these screws.**



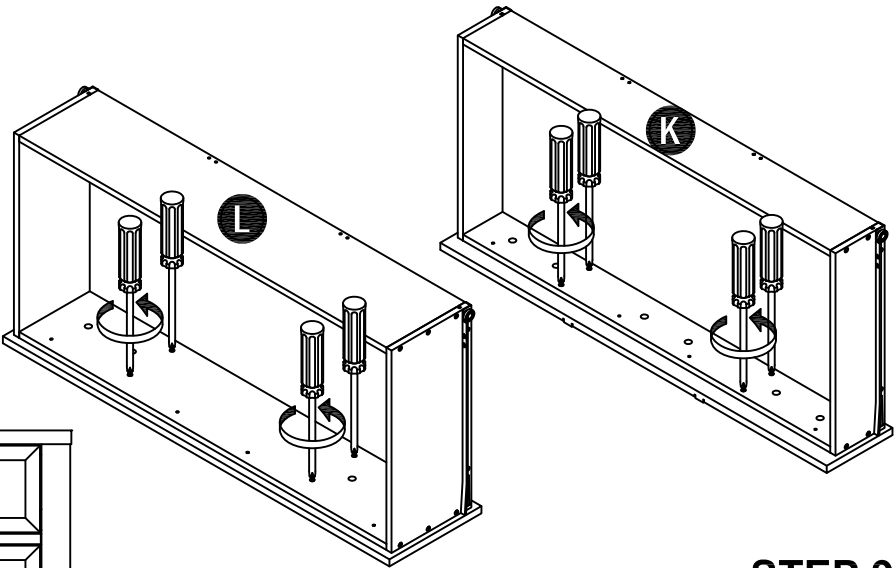
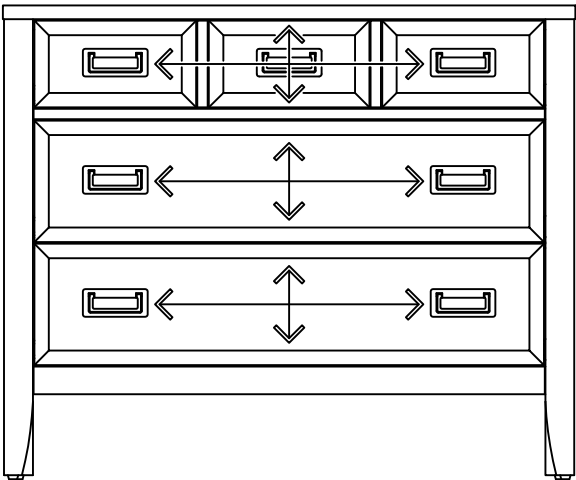
## STEP 7

Slide Drawers (K) and (L) into place.

Note: Follow the steps on the next page to use 3/4" Flat Head Screws to complete drawer assembly.

STEP 8

Loosen slightly the four screws pre-installed on the back of the drawer fronts.

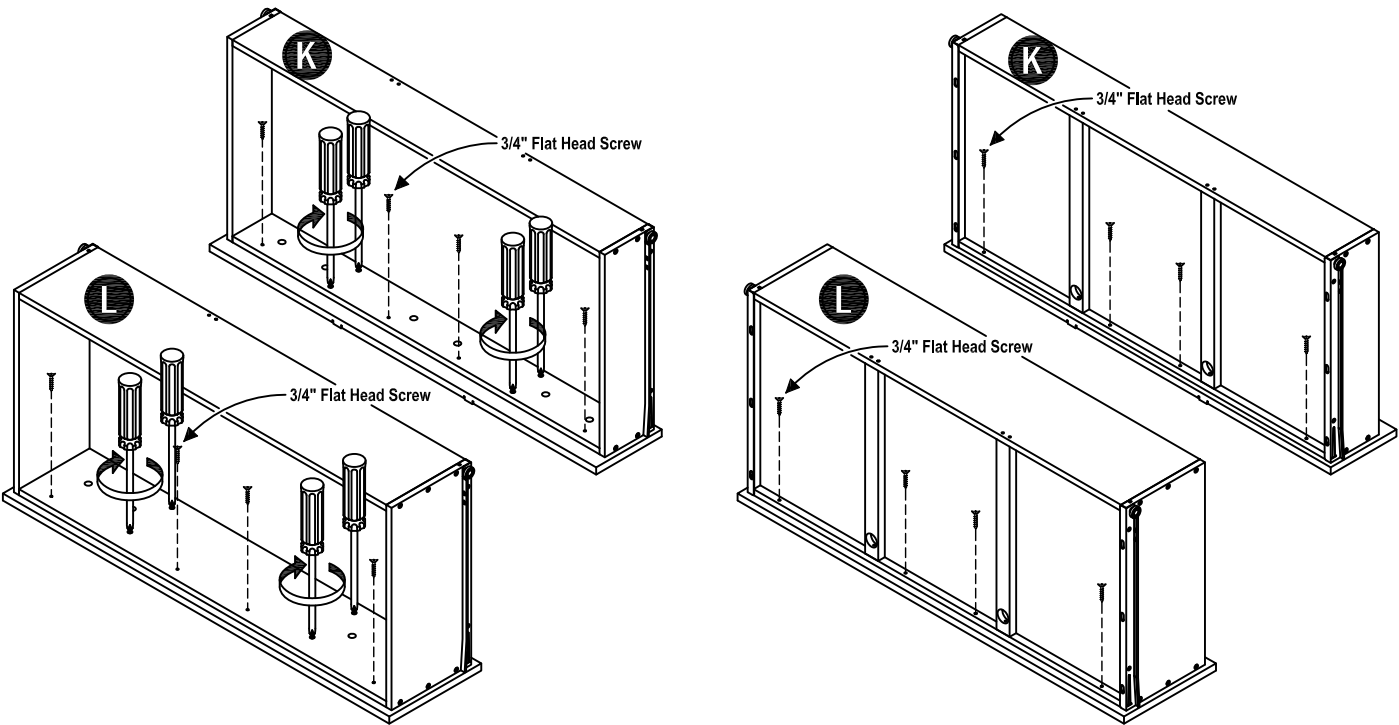


STEP 9

Insert the drawers into the main body, then adjust the drawer front panels left or right and up or down until the drawer gaps look proportional.

STEP 10

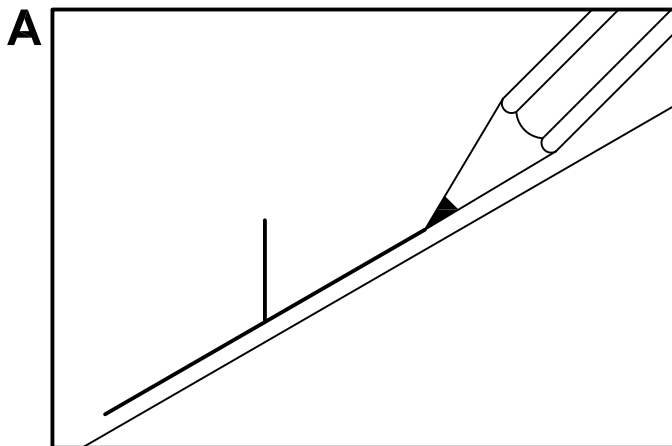
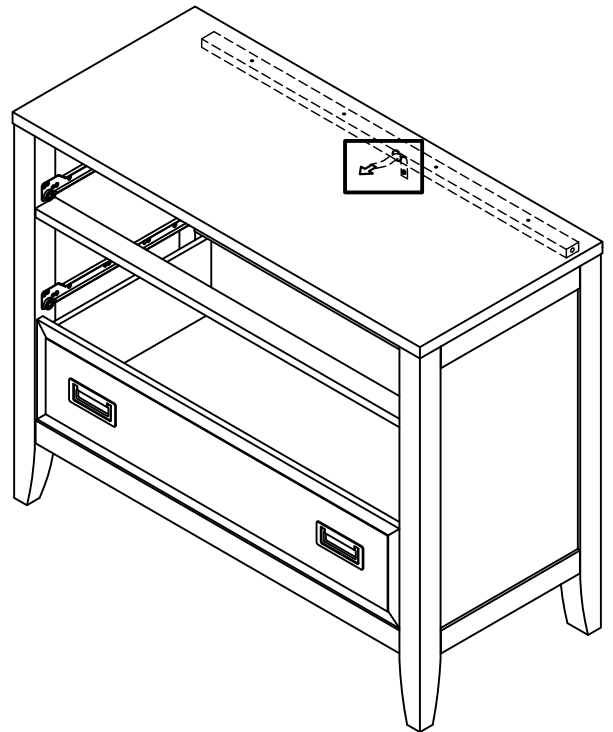
Pull the drawers open slowly and re-tighten the screws from Step 8. Make sure the front panels do not move and lock the drawer front panels into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.



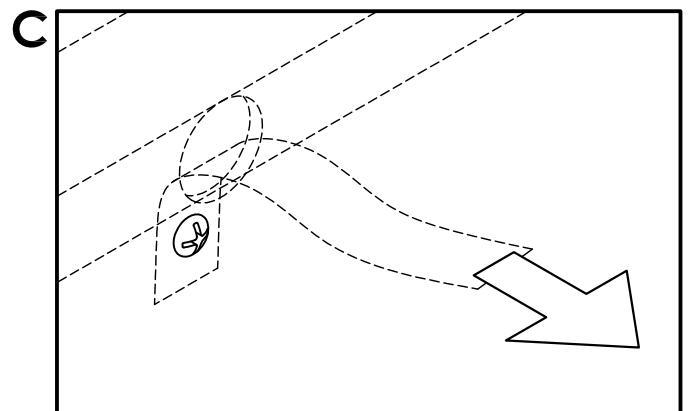
**Note:** These 3/4" Flat Head Screws on this page must be installed to complete the drawer assembly.

## ATTENTION!

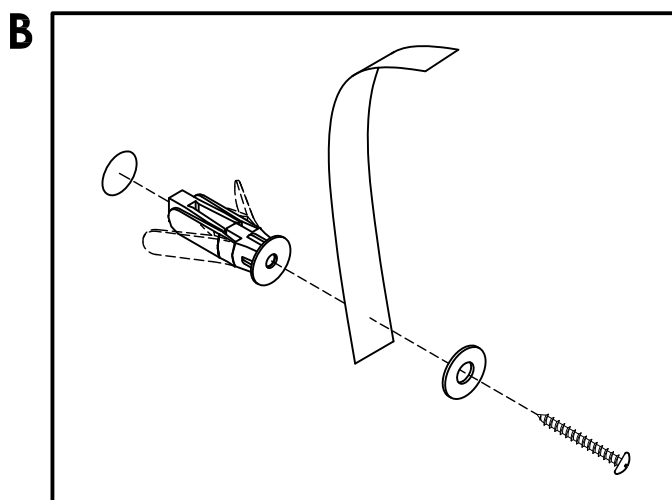
To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tipover Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly!



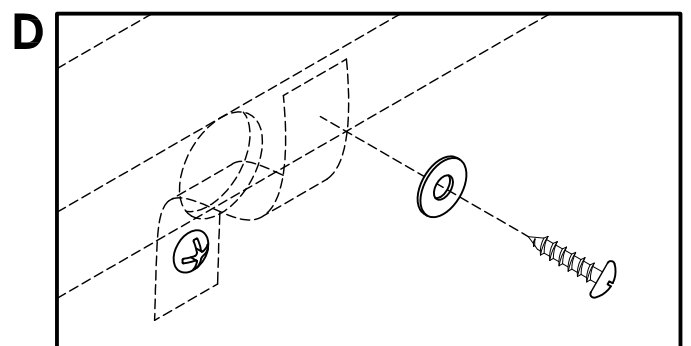
- Place the unit at desired location.
- Remove Drawers (K,L) from unit.
- Mark wall with pencil to show position of hole in Top (A).
- Move unit.



- Move unit back into place.
- Insert Tipover Restraint into unit through hole in Back Panel (I).

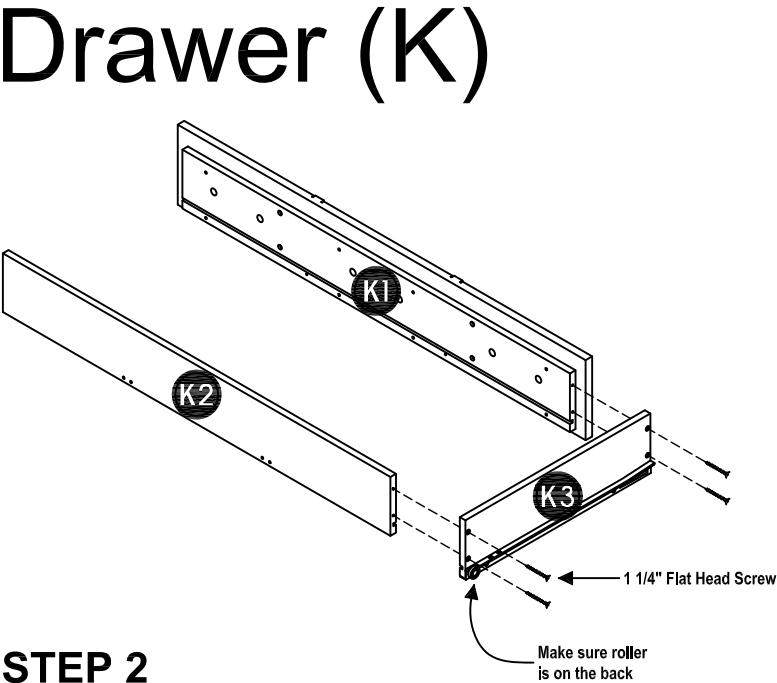


- Drill a 3/8" hole in wall 2 1/2" below mark.
- Insert Anchor into the wall hole.
- Attach Tipover Restraint to Anchor with 1 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer.



- Screw Tipover Restraint to unit with 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer.
- Slide Drawers (K,L) back into place.

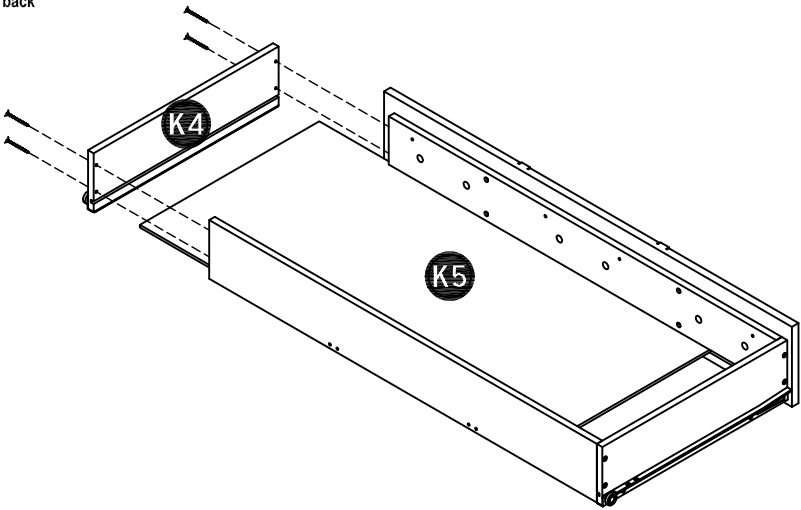
## STEP 1

Attach Side Part (K3) to Front Part (K1) and Back Part (K2) using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

## STEP 2

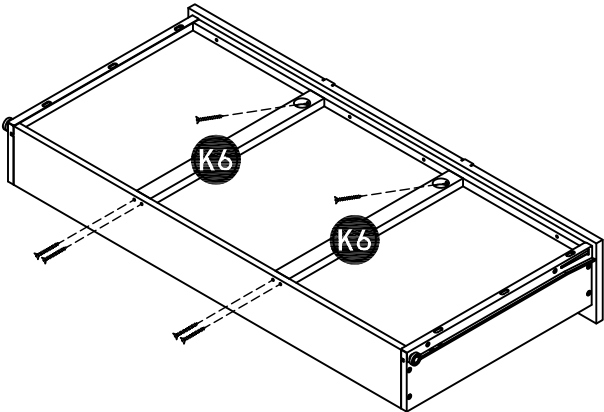
Insert Base Part (K5) into the groove.

Attach Side Part (K4) to unit using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.









## STEP 3

Attach Base Part (K6) to unit using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.



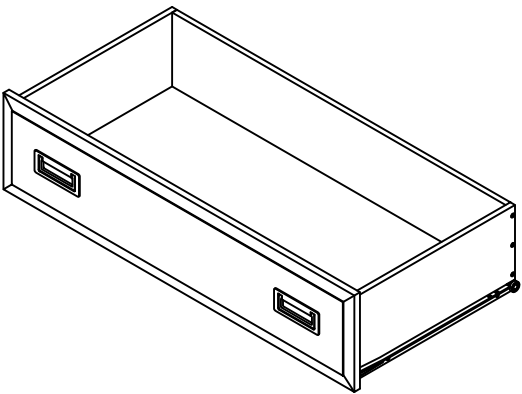
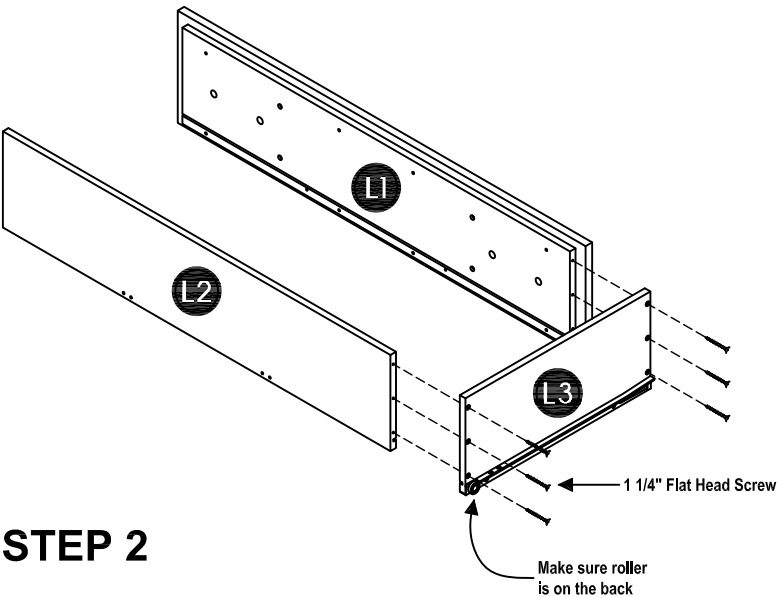

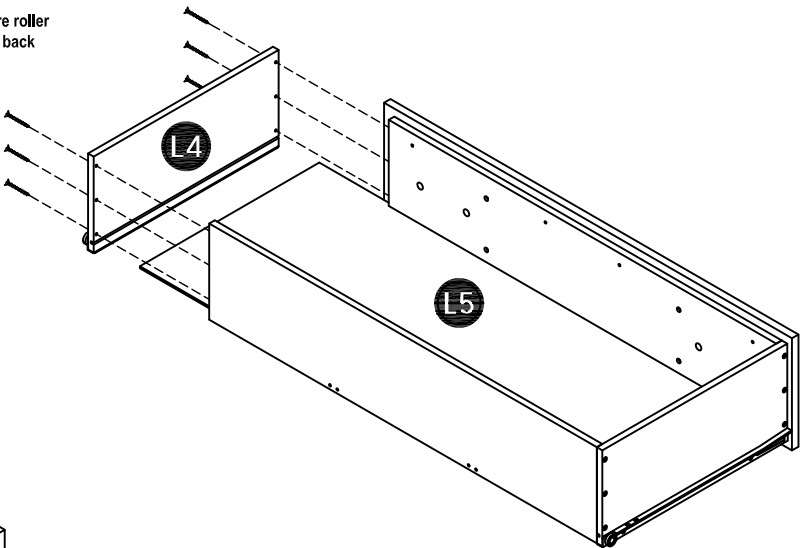
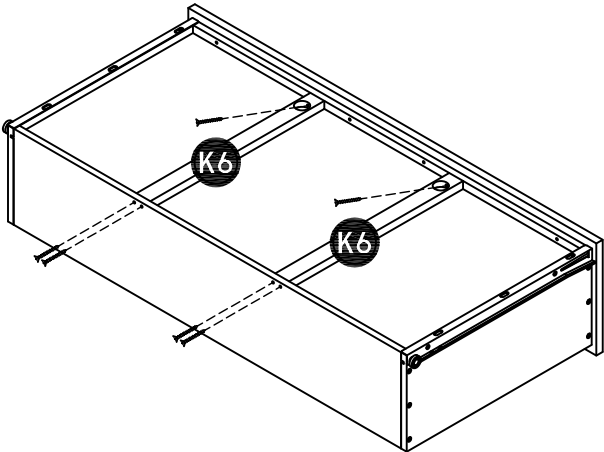
## STEP 1

Insert Base Part (L5) into the groove.







Attach Side Part (L4) to unit using a Phillips screwdriver and 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.
